



Dear Friend of the Town Hall Library,

To many of us, it may seem like yesterday that we opened the doors to our updated Town Hall Library. Actually, it was August 2009 when we introduced our community to dramatically increased space, comfortable seating, enhanced accessibility, and a children's area that more than doubled in size.

Those improvements were enthusiastically received by our members. But there are still three areas which need immediate attention. The Town Hall Library Foundation Board asks your help in funding these items:

• Even though the children's area was enlarged in 2009, more space is needed due to the popularity of our programs (and that's a good thing!). We would like to open up the area into the unfinished space available in the Library's basement to offer more room for materials and add a small theater space to accommodate programming. In addition, an expansion of the children's area would make the downstairs restrooms (already constructed) accessible to families - no more running upstairs to get to the facilities.


- The new restrooms added during the previous renovation are wonderful. However, the facilities in the old section of the Library were not updated. We would like to update the women's and men's rooms with the same type of environmentally friendly fixtures as are in the new section of the Library.
- Our Library staff is known throughout the area as friendly, knowledgeable and capable. What they are not is omniscient. With three floors, it is impossible for staff at the Circulation Desk to know who is on the upper and lower levels and what they are doing. To protect the Library and its patrons, we would like to add security cameras.
